Section I

A. Project Goals:

The "Splash of Confidence Beyond Sight" program was designed with the primary goal of empowering individuals with visual impairments by equipping them with essential swimming and water safety skills in a safe, supportive, and inclusive learning environment. The aim was not only to teach swimming as a sport but use it as a medium for building self-confidence, independence, and resilience among the participants.

Beyond the physical benefits, the program also intended to create a positive social and emotional impact. Swimming is often associated with enjoyment, recreation, and a sense of freedom – experiences that are sometimes limited for those with disabilities due to accessibility and safety concerns. By addressing these barriers, the project sought to open new opportunities for visually impaired individuals to participate in aquatic activities with confidence.

Another crucial objective of this initiative was to raise public awareness about the potential of visually impaired individuals in sports and physical activities. Many people hold the misconception that disabilities inherently limit one's ability to engage in certain recreational or athletic pursuits. This program aimed to break those stereotypes by showcasing how proper training, adaptive methods, and patience can bridge the gap between limitations and possibilities.

In essence, the program was not only about teaching swimming; it was about instilling courage, fostering inclusivity, and providing a platform where participants could feel valued and capable while engaging in an activity that many take for granted.





B. Fund-raising support & Other external sponsorship:

The "Splash of Confidence Beyond Sight" program was made possible through the collaborative efforts of multiple parties. The project was fully sponsored by the **My Starfish Foundation**, which provided a total of **RM 3,126.00** in funding. This generous contribution covered essential expenses such as safety equipment, instructor fees, transportation arrangements, and refreshments for participants.

Additionally, the program was supported by the Defence Fitness Academy (Akademi Kecergasan Pertahanan), whose members contributed their time, expertise, and manpower to organize and run the sessions. The involvement of these committed individuals ensured that the program was not only well-funded but also executed with professionalism, care, and dedication to the participants.

C. Project Implementation:

1. Project Flow Summary:

a. November-December 2024 – Initial Planning and Coordination

During this stage, the organizing committee worked on conceptualizing the program structure, securing funding, and arranging collaborations with certified swimming instructors experienced in working with individuals with visual impairments. Meetings were held to establish safety protocols, lesson plans, and participant engagement strategies.

b. Early January 2025 - Preparation and Logistics

Before the first swimming session, the necessary equipment, such as floatation devices, swimming aids, and tactile markers for pool orientation, was prepared. Volunteers were trained in how to provide physical and verbal guidance to visually impaired swimmers.

c. Program Dates

- **8 January 2025 –** First session: Introduction to swimming environment, water familiarization, and basic safety rules.
- 9 January 2025 Second session: Basic floating techniques, breath control, and confidence-building exercises.
- **15 January 2025 –** Third session: Introduction to basic swimming strokes and independent movement in the water.
- 16 January 2025 Final session: Skill consolidation, simulated rescue exercise, and celebratory closing activities.





2. Difficulties

While the program was successfully implemented, several challenges arose during execution:

- Varied Comfort Levels in Water: Participants had differing levels of familiarity with swimming, which meant lessons had to be adapted individually. This required the additional attention and patience of the instructor to ensure each person progressed at their own pace.
- **Communication Adjustments:** For visually impaired individuals, instructions had to be highly descriptive, using precise verbal cues and hands-on guidance, which demanded more time and careful coordination.
- **Logistical Coordination:** Arranging transportation for participants to and from the swimming facility while ensuring punctuality and safety was a constant challenge.
- **Weather Conditions:** As some sessions were conducted in an outdoor pool, weather unpredictability had to be managed through contingency planning.

3. Language or Cultural Barriers

Communication with participants was generally smooth, although guiding visually impaired individuals requires an added level of patience and attentiveness. Instructors and volunteers learned to give instructions clearly and in detail, avoiding visual references that might be unhelpful to the participants. The sessions also fostered a warm and friendly atmosphere, where mutual respect and understanding became the foundation of interaction.

4. Project Implementation Process

The program's success was largely due to strong teamwork and clear role distribution among committee members. Each team member understood their responsibilities, from participant registration to in-pool guidance, which allowed for smooth execution across all four days of the program.

Partnership with experienced instructors ensured that swimming lessons were adapted effectively for participants' needs. The presence of trained volunteers provided a high level of safety and personal support. The cooperative spirit of all





involved – organizers, instructors, volunteers, and participants - resulted in a positive and memorable experience.

5. Beneficiaries

The program directly benefited **visually impaired students** from various backgrounds. In total, participants gained not only technical swimming skills but also increased confidence in their ability to navigate and enjoy water-based activities.

Indirectly, the program benefited family members, caregivers, and the broader community by demonstrating the capabilities of visually impaired individuals and promoting inclusivity in sports. It also inspired volunteers and organizers to continue supporting disability-friendly initiatives in the future.

6. Post-Project Reflections

The "Splash of Confidence Beyond Sight" program marked an important milestone in promoting sports inclusivity for people with visual impairments. It helps individuals improve mental and physical health and encourages community integration.

Looking ahead, the organizing committee intends to replicate and expand the program to reach more participants in different regions. There is also a vision to introduce similar inclusive initiatives in other sports, thereby furthering the mission of accessibility and equality in physical activities.





Section II (a)

How does or will your project contribute to happiness? Short-term? Long-term?

The "Splash of Confidence Beyond Sight" program was designed with the primary aim of creating joy, empowerment, and a sense of achievement for individuals with visual impairments, while also encouraging inclusivity and community support. In the short term, the program offers participants the chance to break away from their often predictable and limited daily routines by engaging in a stimulating and refreshing outdoor activity-swimming. Swimming, as a physical activity, not only improves physical health but also encourages mental relaxation, confidence building, and social interaction. For many participants, this program is their first opportunity to engage in a structured swimming session tailored to their abilities, conducted in an environment that is both safe and supportive.

In the immediate sense, the program sparks happiness through the experience of learning new skills, overcoming fears, and feeling the thrill of being in the water – something that many people take for granted. The swimming sessions are adapted to the needs of the participants, with trained instructors, proper safety measures, and guiding techniques to ensure that the visually impaired can fully enjoy the experience without unnecessary limitations. Each successful stroke, each moment of balance in the water, and each cheer from the instructors and peers reinforces a participant's confidence, ultimately turning apprehension into pride and accomplishment.

In the long term, "Splash of Confidence Beyond Sight" contributes to the well-being of participants far beyond the pool. Regular exposure to aquatic activities can strengthen physical stamina, improve cardiovascular health, and enhance motor coordination. More importantly, the program builds a sense of resilience and independence. Participants are encouraged to trust themselves and their capabilities, despite their visual limitations, which can positively influence other areas of their lives, from education to employment. The social bonds formed during the program – both between participants and with the volunteers – can foster a lasting sense of community and belonging. Additionally, by raising awareness about adaptive sports, the project has the potential to inspire more organizations to adopt inclusive programs, creating a ripple effect of accessibility and happiness across society.





Has your project changed the way you think about the world? How has it changed you?

Working on the "Splash of Confidence Beyond Sight" program has been a transformative journey for our team. We began with the logistical challenges of planning an inclusive swimming event – from securing a suitable venue and specialized trainers to developing safety protocols and personalized teaching methods for individuals with visual impairments. Along the way, we learned that while technical preparation is important, what truly makes a difference is the shared commitment and willingness of people to work together towards a meaningful goal.

One of the most eye-opening aspects of this experience was seeing how much determination and courage the participants brought with them. Many arrived at the pool with understandable hesitation, unsure of how they would adapt to a new environment. Yet, as the sessions progressed, their trust grew – in us, in the water, and most importantly, in themselves. This trust was a reminder that confidence is built through empathy, patience, and consistent support.

The project also shifted our perception of inclusion. We realized that true inclusivity is not just about making activities "accessible" but about reimagining them in ways that allow every individual to participate with dignity and joy. The smiles, laughter, and shared moments of celebration at the end of each session were not just signs of a successful program – they were proof that happiness is mostly deeply felt when it is shared.

This journey has left us inspired to continue creating opportunities for marginalized communities, recognizing that even small contributions can have a life-changing impact. It has reinforced our belief that the world becomes a kinder, richer place when we take active steps to ensure that no one is left behind.
