The initiative aims to provide 20 solar lamps and 2 Solar Spotlight near Kampung Mangkapoh in Ranau to enhance visibility and reduce the risk of accidents during night-time and early morning hours. By improving lighting conditions, the project will enable villagers to carry out work, household chores, business activities, and recreational pursuits even after sunset. The solar lamps will be distributed and installed in strategic locations, particularly on suspension bridges throughout the rural area, to ensure maximum coverage and impact.

# 2. Difficulties

- Kampung Mangkapoh is situated in a remote and rural area, making it less accessible for standard transportation services.
- The project was implemented within a limited budget with the majority of funds allocated to essential project components. Additional expenses, including student travel, accommodation, meals, and logistical support, were fully selffunding.
- The installation process was temporarily halted due to the rainy season.

# 3. Language or cultural barriers

The solar lamp installation project in Kampung Mangkapoh, Ranau, Sabah, involved close collaboration between the villagers and the student team. Throughout the project, we experienced strong community engagement, with villagers actively participating in the installation process.

### 4. Project Implementation Process

Overall, the solar lamp installation project in Kampung Mangkapoh went smoothly and efficiently, thanks to the clear division of responsibilities among our team members. Each individual was well-informed of their tasks, which contributed to effective coordination and implementation. In addition, the full cooperation and trust extended by the village head and local community members greatly supported the success of the project. We were pleased to see that the villagers expressed their satisfaction and appreciation for the improved lighting infrastructure. Lastly, the project successfully raised the targeted amount through crowdfunding, which not only supported the installation but also fostered greater public awareness and involvement in addressing rural community needs.

On the other hand, the project faced challenges related to the high cost of materials, particularly the poles required to support the solar lamps. The standard lamp posts were expensive and exceeded the initial budget. To address this issue, the team opted to use square steel tubes as an alternative. These square tubes were more cost-effective while still offering the necessary durability and stability for the installation. This solution allowed the project to stay within budget without compromising on quality or safety.

#### 5. Beneficiaries

The installation of solar lamps in Kampung Mangkapoh has significantly benefited the local community by improving visibility and enhancing navigation during nighttime and early morning hours. This has contributed to a safer and more accessible environment, particularly in areas such as pathways and suspension bridges that were previously difficult to navigate in low-light conditions. A total of 560 individuals directly benefited from this project, including approximately 410 villagers and 150 students. The improved lighting has also enabled extended hours for daily activities, increased safety, and enhanced the overall quality of life for the community.

#### 6. Post-project

This project marked our first practical application of civil engineering in planning, design, and on-site execution to complete a real-world infrastructure project that directly benefits a rural community. The entire process from site assessment and material selection to collaborative construction with the villagers was guided by considerations of functionality, sustainability, and community impact. By addressing the issue of inadequate lighting, the project has contributed to creating a safer and more accessible environment for Kampung Mangkapoh especially during night-time and dawn hours.

The solar lamp installation project in Kampung Mangkapoh contributes to the overall happiness and well-being of the local community by addressing a basic yet essential need which is safe and reliable lighting. In the short term, the installation of solar lamps improves visibility during night time and early morning hours, making it easier and safer for villagers to move around, especially in areas like suspension bridges and footpaths. This has reduced the risk of accidents and increased the sense of security within the village.

In the long term, the project enhances the villagers' quality of life by enabling evening activities such as studying, working, socializing, and participating in community events. Furthermore, the use of solar energy promotes sustainability and environmental awareness, contributing to a happier and more hopeful future for Kampung Mangkapoh.

The experience taught us that meaningful change doesn't always require large-scale intervention. Even small initiatives like installing solar lamps can significantly improve a community's well-being. 




